ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY (“RELEASE”)

ALL PATRONS OF ANGRY PELICAN CHARTERS MUST COMPLETE, SIGN AND DATE THIS RELEASE BEFORE BEING PERMITTED TO BOARD THE VESSEL. ALL PATRONS WHO ARE AGES 18 AND OVER MUST SIGN HIS OR HER OWN SEPARATE RELEASE.

The undersigned Primary Releasor [and any Secondary Releasors named below who are under the age of eighteen (18) years old, if applicable], intend to take part in a chartered ocean-going fishing trip in the Atlantic Ocean and its associated in-shore waterways (the “Charter Fishing Activities”) on a charter fishing boat maintained, captained and crewed by Angry Pelican Charters (the “Vessel”). NOTE: The Primary Releasor and all Secondary Releasors are sometimes collectively referred to herein as the “Releasor(s).”

The Primary Releasor is deemed for all purposes (including, but not limited to, the purpose of executing this Release) to be the legal custodian and guardian of all Secondary Releasors, authorized by all of same (and by their respective parents or legal guardians) to execute this Release on their behalf and to be responsible for the Secondary Releasors’ behavior and actions related to the Vessel and the Charter Fishing Activities, and Primary Releasor acknowledges, warrants and represents that he/she is so authorized.

Releasor(s) represent(s) to Angry Pelican Charters that Primary Releasor and all Secondary Releasors, to the best of their knowledge, do not suffer from any illness or other health condition that would prohibit, or otherwise render unsafe or impracticable, their occupancy of the Vessel or their participation in the Charter Fishing Activities. Releasor(s) further understand(s) and acknowledge(s) that: (i) the Vessel has limited first aid supplies onboard; (ii) the Vessel may in some instances be several hours out to sea; (iii) in the event of illness or injury, appropriate medical personnel must be summoned by radio and medical care will be delayed until the ill or injured party may be transported to a medical facility. Angry Pelican Charters reserves the right to refuse or discontinue services to any person who appears incapable of meeting the physical and mental requirements to safely enter, occupy, remain upon, and exit the Vessel and participate in the Charter Fishing Activities.

Releasor(s) acknowledge(s) and agree(s) that: (a) there are present on the Vessel sufficient Type 1 Personal Flotation Devices (PFDs) for every passenger and crew member’s use while onboard the Vessel per the applicable United States Coast Guard Regulations; and (b) North Carolina law requires all passengers under the age of thirteen (13) years to wear a PFD while onboard the Vessel. While all passengers are strongly advised and encouraged by Angry Pelican Charters to wear PFDs at all times while onboard the Vessel, Primary Releasor shall be solely responsible, in the exercise of Primary Releasor’s own judgment, for determining whether Primary Releasor or any Secondary Releasor(s) wear PFDs while onboard the Vessel. Provided, however, in the event of unusually high seas or other hazardous conditions, all persons shall be required to wear a PFD if directed at any time to do so by the Vessel’s captain or staff.

THE USE, POSSESSION OR CONSUMPTION OF ILLEGAL DRUGS OR CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ONBOARD THE VESSEL IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES MAY ONLY BE POSSESSED OR CONSUMED BY PERSONS AT LEAST TWENTY-ONE (21) YEARS OLD. The use or consumption of alcohol or drugs may increase the risk of injury around water, boats and fishing equipment. Therefore, persons of lawful age who choose to consume alcohol are urged to do so in moderation. All passengers on the Vessel have a duty to exercise reasonable care and caution for their own safety and the safety of others while on or around the Vessel. Leaving the Vessel (other than at the direction of Angry Pelican Charters’ personnel), throwing litter or objects into the water, or jumping into the water or other horseplay onboard the Vessel or at the place where the Vessel is docked are strictly prohibited.
